2012 Price List and Booking Information for Four, Five, Seven, Ten & Twenty Day Courses and Court Appearances

All bookings are a minimum of four days which can be organized as follows:

Working with dogs - minimum 1 day but can be combined with any other courses to give a total of four days (bring your own dogs).

Subjects:

1. Obedience
2. Companion Dog Training
3. Working trials
4. Tracking
5. Search and Rescue
6. Basic Agility
7. Fun and Games

Maximum number of handlers working dogs per day = **20** (maximum of **12** for Tracking and Search and Rescue courses) unlimited number of auditors

Times: Strictly 9.30 - 4.00 daily

Fee is £600 per day regardless of the number of handlers (max. 20 – 14 for tracking) or auditors

2 day Lectures (no dogs)

Subjects:

1. Dog Behaviour Foundation
2. Raising and Training a Puppy
3. Conducting Dog Training Classes
4. Behaviour Modification Programs (not including Aggression)
5. Regaining Control

The lectures listed above **do not** give an in depth view of aggression.

Course fee = £1,200

Four day courses (uses selected dogs)

Subjects:

1. Foundation Course in Canine Behaviour
2. Canine Aggression
3. Puppy Development
4. Canine Welfare and Rehabilitation
5. Ultimate Recall

Times: Strictly 9.00 - 4.00 daily

Limited to **40** students

Course fee = £2,400

Five day courses (uses selected dogs)

Subjects:

1. Foundation Course in Canine Behaviour
2. Training and Instructing

Times: Strictly 9.00 - 4.00 daily

Limited to **30** students

Course fee = £3,000

- A deposit of £50.00 is due **at the time of booking** which is payable directly to John Rogerson.
- The course organiser is responsible for the cost of transportation for Ireland, and countries outside England, Scotland, and Wales. John will arrange his own transportation via the least expensive means possible. In England, Scotland, and Wales the £600 daily fee includes fuel expenses travelling to the course and back to John's home.
- The organiser is responsible for accommodation and food beginning one night before the seminar and ending the morning after the seminar finishes. On occasion, John will arrive a few days early and depart a few days after the seminar. Though you're not responsible for the extra nights lodging, it would be very helpful for John if you could make the necessary arrangements.
- Appropriate insurances to cover public liability, cancellation due to ill health, weather etc, are the responsibility of the event organizer and should waive John and Judy Rogerson of all liability associated with any information or advice given at any of his offered courses. Proof of insurance needs to be submitted prior to the start of the event.

Cancellations:

If for any unforeseen reasons you have to cancel the booking, up to 6 months before the date of the seminar, you forfeit the deposit of £50.00.

Fees for court appearances as expert witness:

£85 per hour for written report (usually three to four hours)

£125 per hour for behaviour testing (usually two to three hours)

£500 per day for court appearance as expert witness plus accommodation (if needed) and travel expenses
